

Chapter 46 - Food Establishments

1. Adoption of Code by Reference.

Pursuant to the Charter of the City of Troy and the provisions of Section 3 (k) of Act 279 of 1909, State of Michigan, as amended, the Oakland County Department of Health Rules and Regulations Relating to Food Establishments, Resolution 4351, effective September 21, 1964, as amended through September 21, 1966, prepared and promulgated by and through the Health Committee of the Oakland County Board of Health, are hereby adopted in their entirety by the City of Troy for the purpose of issuing permits, establishing sanitary standards, for the purpose of issuing permits, establishing sanitary standards, controlling the sale, storage, processing, distribution, display and serving of foods and to safeguard and health of the public patronizing such food handling establishments and to protect the public from any health nuisance or health hazard arising from the operating of such establishments in the City of Troy.
